Radmila Obradovic (DOB: March 11, 1976) is a professor of Oral Medicine, Periodontology, Laser-Therapy in Dentistry, Periodontal Surgery and Oral Hygiene at the University of Niš, Medical Faculty, Department for Oral Medicine and Periodontology, and at the University of Kragujevac, Faculty of Medical Sciences, Department for Stomatology, Republic of Serbia.

She specializes in the investigation of periodontal disease in diabetic patients and the application of low-level lasers in dentistry. She was awarded her Master's degree in 2005 with a thesis on "Comparative analysis of the biomaterials and low level laser therapy efficiency in bone defect's reparation – experimental study" and her PhD in 2010 with a thesis on "The importance of low level lasers periodontal therapy in diabetics".

She authored many publications, lectured at numerous national and international meetings. She was awarded the 2009 prize for the best publication by the University of Niš, Medical Faculty, Department for Dentistry.

She is a Board member of the International Journal of Oral and Craniofacial Science, Sanamed Journal, JSM Dental Surgery and Stomatology Edu Journal. She is also a member of the section for periodontology and oral medicine SLD (Serbian Medical Society), the intersection for the application of lasers in dentistry SLD SOLAS (Serbian Oral Laser Society - Serbian Medical Society) and Dental Chamber of Serbia. She is also a reviewer for numerous academic journals such as the Journal of Photochemistry and Photobiology B: Biology (ELSEVIER), Academic Journals, Sanamed Journal and many more.
